## General information about Church of Uganda Kisiizi Hospital:

There will be a group of volunteers taking part in the professional MDT 2026 Uganda Project. The volunteers will be working at C.O.U Kisiizi Hospital in South West Uganda <a href="http://www.kisiizihospital.org.ug">http://www.kisiizihospital.org.ug</a>. C.O.U. Kisiizi Hospital is a 260- bed rural Ugandan hospital located in the village of Kisiizi. The team will work on various projects, building on the work completed 2015-2025 and gain experience in their various disciplines.

The team will stay in The Kisiizi Falls Guest House. They will have safe drinking water, freshly prepared cooked meals, running water and beds with mosquito nets throughout their stay and while travelling to and from the hospital. Wifi is available in Kisiizi and generally works very well, which facilitates communication with the outside world. The team will also have designated contact numbers and volunteers should be able to avail of the option to purchase an inexpensive sim card in the Ugandan capital or local town (Kabale) en route to the hospital and will be reachable at this number during their time in Africa.

The team may avail of the opportunity to visit Lake Bunonyi (Uganda's Deepest Lake) and Queen Elizabeth National Safari Park or Kisoro Mountain Region which are accessible from the hospital on weekends 1 and 2.
